It is a supplier of TIER 1 for the most demanding customers VW GROUP, ŠKODA AUTO, AUDI, GM, FORD, SEAT and for TIER 2 customers APTIV, FUJIKURA, SUMITOMO, KIEKERT, PLASTIC OMNIUM LIGHTING, SMR, FICOMIRRORS, MAGNA, FORVIA and others.

Fair and sustainable access to raw materials on world markets is the first pillar of the EU's raw materials initiative. The SLUŽBA NITRA, s. r. o. is committed to pursuing raw materials diplomacy aimed at reaching out to third countries through strategic partnerships and political dialogues.

When sourcing raw materials, we monitor compliance with and respect for human rights, prevention of child and forced labor, protection of health and safety of workers and communities, prevention of pollution or excessive use of water, respect for land rights.

We source our materials in a responsible manner that respects human rights and minimizes negative impacts on the environment, sustainable development and protects natural resources.

We reduce overall dependence on indigenous natural resources and the resources we use come from responsible sources. By promoting more sustainable practices, we also want to contribute to long-term sustainability.

We take due care in identifying, assessing and addressing priority risks and impacts on the environment and ascertaining the level of respect for human rights in the extraction of raw materials.

For key materials used in our products, we use supplier data, country of origin, CMRT verified supplier database, and only release suppliers that are marked as released suppliers in the database. CMRT requires suppliers to make their declarations.

They are responsible for proper compliance with this policy, working directly with suppliers of raw materials, materials, components and products.

We transfer the requirements of Raw Material Policy Responsibility to suppliers in the form of a written commitment from Supplier's in the Code of Conduct. Suppliers are obliged to submit a binding and truthful scope of documentation according to the requirements for REACH, CMRT, EMRT, CRT Cobalt, IMDS.

We require suppliers to train their employees in respect of human rights, prevention of child and slave labor, health and safety requirements, legal and factual requirements of provided documentation and reporting obligations.
